Fernando Dasilva creates a chain maille inspired bracelet.

## Material:

2 14 mm Crystal Copper Swarovski Elements Cosmic Pendants
4 11 x 5.5 mm Crystal Copper Swarovski Elements Briolette Pendants
16 4 mm Olivine Dorado Swarovski Elements Bicone Beads
16 4mm Tourmaline Swarovski Elements Bicone Beads
16 3mm Olivine AB Swarovski Elements Round Pendants
39 gold plated 4way flower connectors
68 gold plated 3.5mm lightweight jump rings
2 3.5 x 4.5 gold-plated oval jump rings
1 set of gold-plated hook-and-eye clasp
1 set of gold-plated 3 to 1 Victorian ring connectors
48 small gold-plated ball head pins

### Tools:

Chain-nose pliers Round-nose pliers Jump ring tool Pinch bail pliers

#### Instructions:

#### 1. Begin to connect flowers

Using chain nose pliers and the jump ring tool, open all the 3.5mm jump rings, pulling them open just enough to accept the ring on the flower connectors. Use the jump rings to make a 13 flowers together.

#### 2. Create 3 strands of connected flowers

Repeat step 1 to make a total of 3 strands of 13 linked flowers. Make sure to take the time to securely close each jump ring as fully as possible to ensure a really wonderful finish. Use 3.5 jump rings to link all 3 strands together.

#### 3. Connect gold strands to clasp

Link the end of each strand to the corresponding loop on a 3-to-1 connector. Repeat for the other end of the bracelet. Link each component of the clasp to and end of the bracelet with a single oval jump ring.

#### 4. Create large dangles


Slide a copper crystal cosmic pendant onto a pinch bail and squeeze the pinch bail closed with pinch bail pliers. Slide a 4mm jump ring onto the loop of the pinch bail. Repeat with a second cosmic pendant. Slide each copper briolette onto a 4mm jump ring. Set these dangles aside.

#### 5. Link dangles to bracelet

Slide a tourmaline bicone onto a ball head pin and turn a loop above the bead. Repeat to make dangles with all the tourmaline and olivine bicones and all the olivine ab rounds. Link 2 olivine dangles to each of the first 2 outside holes on both sides of the bracelet. At the middle, slide a briolette, a cosmic pendant and another briolette onto the flower loop.

Bead the second half of the bracelet in the same manner as the first.
