2407-2 Omega Choker Necklace Designed by Katie Hacker

Materials needed
Leather Cord USA Large-size bolo cord
Leather Cord USA 1.5mm round leather cord; metallic gray
Leather Cord USA Loctite Quiktite Gel Glue
Halcraft Bead Gallery feather charms with jump rings
Halcraft Bead Gallery faceted firepolish rounds
Halcraft Bead Gallery square spacer rondelles
Beadalon necklace-size flat memory wire
Beadalon memory wire pliers
Beadalon memory wire cutters
10 head pins

Instructions

two 6" lengths of curb chain

- 1. Cut one loop of memory wire and use memory wire pliers to make a large loop on one end.
- 2. Pass the wire through the bolo cord and make another loop.
- 3. Cut a 6" length of round leather cord and coil it around one end of the bolo. Place both ends of the cord through the coil and pull the ends tight. Add a drop of glue. Repeat for the other end of the choker.
- 4. Attach a length of chain to each end of the necklace.
- 5. Open the jump rings on the feather charms and arrange them in a staggered pattern on the chains.
- 6. Pass a head pin through a firepolish bead, spacer bead and make a small basic loop; repeat for each head pin.
- 7. Attach the beaded dangles in-between the feather charms.
