## **Recycled Tea Tin Earrings**

## Materials: Tea tin 30mm kidney wires

Matte gold cube beads

## **Tools and Supplies:**

Can opener

Metal scissors

Sandpaper or emery board

Metal hole punch

Gold paint pen

Cardboard (for template)

Sharpie

## Instructions:

- 1. With can opener held upside down, pierce around rim of tea tin until rim and can top are separated from can.
- 2. With metal scissors (or tin snips) cut can into rectangles.
- 3. Draw teardrop template onto cardboard and cut out with scissors.
- 4. Trace template onto can in desired position. Repeat to make two teardrop shapes.
- 5. With metal scissors, cut out teardrops.
- 6. With emery board (or sandpaper) sand sharp edges smooth.
- 7. With metal hole punch, punch hole at top center of teardrop shape. Remover burs and sand back of hole if needed.
- 8. With gold paint pen, draw an outline around teardrop, and draw a sloppy, larger line at bottom of teardrop as shown.
- 9. Assemble earrings by slipping pendant onto kidney wire, and add matte cube beads to wire as shown.
