Level of difficulty: beginner



Time – about 1 hour

Tip: Starting and ending your bracelet in the same or similar simple gold rounds gives it continuity.

Instructions:

- 1 Use the memory wire pliers to form a loop at the end of the memory wire.
- 2 String one "round" (a full circle of beads) of each of the beads in the list above in that order—or play around and choose your own patterns!
- 3 Use memory wire shears to cut the memory wire about 1/4" from the final bead. Form a loop at the end of the memory wire.
