Materials:

- 10288412 Bead Gallery® 3mm gold rounds
- 10393358 Bead Gallery® Iris luster hematite squares
- 10392198 Bead Gallery® matte gold Czech glass bicones
- 10471826 Bead Gallery® 2x6mm gold heishi rondelles
- 91414 Bead Gallery® 8x5mm gold faceted glass coins
- 10467564 Bead Gallery® 3x6mm hematite matte rectangles
- 85136 Bead Gallery® 6mm gold faceted rounds
- 10288413 Bead Gallery® 4mm gold rounds
- 10162868 Beadalon® gold plated memory wire

Tools:

- 10390893 Beadalon® memory wire pliers
- 10332397 Beadalon® memory wire shears

Level of difficulty: beginner

Time – about 1 hour

Tip: Starting and ending your bracelet in the same or similar simple gold rounds gives it continuity.

Instructions:

- 1 Use the memory wire pliers to form a loop at the end of the memory wire.
- 2 String one “round” (a full circle of beads) of each of the beads in the list above in that order—or play around and choose your own patterns!
- 3 Use memory wire shears to cut the memory wire about 1/4” from the final bead. Form a loop at the end of the memory wire.
