

Personalized Wine Charm

Skill Level: Easy

Tools & Supplies

- ImpressArt® Ergo-Angle™ Metal Stamping Hammer
- ImpressArt® Steel Block
- ImpressArt® Stamp Enamel Marker™
- ImpressArt® Stamp Guides™
- ImpressArt® Stamp Tape™
- ImpressArt® Letter, Number, & Design Number Stamps
- ImpressArt® Wine Charms, Aluminum, w/ 25mm Hoops
- Polishing Cloth, Paper Towel, or Clean Rag

Instructions

STEP 1

Place wine charm on stamping block. Secure straight stamp guide on blank. Use guide marks to evenly space out letters and align stamp impressions.

***TIP:** Use stamp tape to secure the stamping blank to the stamping block so it doesn't move while stamping.

***TIP:** Write desired message directly onto the stamp guide and utilize the guideline marks for spacing.

STEP 2

Place stamp on wine charm, above the corresponding mark on the stamp guide. Lightly drag stamp towards the guide until the stamp catches the edge of the guide. Hold stamp flat and firmly in place by anchoring the side of your hand on workspace. Then strike stamp once with medium force using Metal Stamping Hammer. Repeat to complete desired word.

***TIP:** If the stamp has an ImpressArt logo, make sure it is facing you so that the impression is stamped in the correct direction.

***TIP:** Slightly tilt the stamp towards you while dragging the stamp towards the guide. Make sure you hold the stamp flat and firmly in place before striking the stamp.

STEP 3

Stamp design stamps of your choice around the stamped word to further personalize the wine charm.

***TIP:** Use the Tilt & Tap technique to stamp 6mm and larger stamps, or stamps with more details. While applying pressure to the stamp, strike once with medium force. Then without lifting stamp, continue to strike while very slightly tilting the stamp in a circular motion to catch all sides of the design.

STEP 4

Highlight impressions with Stamp Enamel Marker. Wait 3-5 minutes and then wipe away excess from the surface of the wine charm.

STEP 5

Attach wire hoop to wine charm. Place wine charm around the stem of a wine glass and enjoy!
